

Project Summary

Total Connection Logistic Services (TCLS) was tasked with the full mobilization of a soy-bean plant expansion originating from Winona Terminal with final delivery to a construction site in Fairmont MN.

Total Connection would discharge 75 components onto various specialized flatbed trailers, secure permitting, escorts, and route surveys while over seeing the successful delivery and unloading at the Fairmont site while providing real time updates to client and contributing stakeholders.

Challenges

This project was overshadowed by the invasive corona virus pandemic, so challenges were anticipated from the onset of the project and adjustments were made during the planning process to mitigate these potential problems.



Challenge 1: Severe Equipment Shortages

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Total Connection was faced with a severe driver and equipment shortage. With various state closures and unpredictable capacity, Total connection was challenged with sourcing reliable drivers and specialized equipment in a short window of time.

Solution: We were successfully able to leverage our vast carrier network and secure coverage for every component based on a strict loadout and delivery schedule. This met the client's delivery requirements without delay and allowed them to start the construction of the plant expansion without issues.



Challenge 2: Cancelled Route Surveys

Towards the middle of the project, Total Connection was challenged when the DOT canceled previously approved route surveys potentially compromising the on-time completion of the project and loss of specialized equipment capacity.

Solution: To save additional costs to the client and avoid penalties and fines for unapproved transportation, Total Connection mobilized a route survey team while continuing the load out plan with in-gauge, legal weight components. A new route was completed and approved, and the components were transported without any delays or additional costs to the client.



Challenge 3: Inclement Weather

Inclement weather challenged the unloading of several components on an arriving barge. Lightning and strong winds resulted in a significant delay for the crane operators, and drivers.

Solution: Total Connection was able to negotiate with all drivers and crane operators to minimize demurrage and waiting charges. Thanks to our on-site representation along with our relationship with Winona terminal allowed us to avoid significant extra costs.
